What is Trashion?



- Trashion is a form of wearable art made with non-traditional materials, many of which would be thrown away (like a dress made from plastic trash bags)
- Can also be made with conventional materials in a non-conventional way (Like a dress made with t-shirts, ties, or fabric scraps).
- Can be made with conventional construction (sewing machine, knitting) or with whatever you have on hand (zip ties, hot glue, etc.)
- Can be functional/practical or purely artistic
- Often makes a statement

Why Trashion?



Economic - Many clothes today are made with the idea that they will be worn a few times, start to fall apart, and then get thrown away. Trashion is a creative way of showing that things can be made to last, or re-used once they have served their original purpose

Environmental - Fast Fashion is one of the leading causes of environmental pollution because of chemicals, dyes, water usage,

Ethical - Many clothes today are produced under harsh/illegal/unethical conditions. Making your own clothing is a way of not increasing the need for these harmful business practices
